Prelegerea va fi ținută de Prof. Massimo Farina de la Universitatea din Cagliari / Italia, specialist în Drept Informatic, prezent la Universitatea Transilvania în cadrul Programului Erasmus +. Conținutul seminarului este articulat în următoarele capitole:

The European and Italian legislation on Personal Data Protection and Privacy.

Data protection and security: the legal concepts of privacy and confidentiality. The processing of personal data in the Information Society: general principles. Information obligation and consent. Rights of the data subject. Sensitive Data. Minimum and adequate security measures. Privacy in electronic communication services.

The European and Italian Legislation on Software Protection.

The legal framework on copyright in the Italian legal system: software, databases, multimedia works, websites. Proprietary and Open Source software. The ownership of software developed within research projects/in a company/on the basis of a professional consulting contract. Software licenses, software development contracts. Guided analysis of contracts and relevant clauses.

The European and Italian Legislation on Computer Crimes

Computer crimes: Basic elements of criminal law; concepts of crime, fault and intentional wrongdoing, the principle of strict application. Illicit access to an IT system. Detention and diffusion of codes of access to IT systems. Damaging or interruption of an IT or distance-communication system. Illicit interference in electronic communications. Guided analysis of court decisions.
