## TCC 2023 – Practical info



Time zone: Romania lies in the Eastern European Time Zone, GMT+2.

RON : 1 Euro. You can change money on arrival at the airport or withdraw it from the ATM there. The exchange rate at the airport is 4.5 RON : 1 Euro, so only the minimum amount is recommended to be exchanged here.

**Electricity** : Romanian sockets accept European C and F plugs. Check <u>this</u> <u>website</u> to find more information.





Currency : Romanian Leu's current exchange rate is 4.95

Climate: in Romania is a temperate continental climate. At the beginning of September, we can expect anything: from cold periods with rain or wind, with temperatures between 5°C and 15°C or warm sunny weather with temperatures above 25°C. Please consult the forecast close to your arrival.



#### Accommodation

Accommodation for 31st August - 1st September and 7th - 8th September at Transylvania University Campus in Brașov, with four people per room. From 1st - 7th September, stay at Petru Rareș High School Campus in Târgu Lăpuș. Rooms for four with individual bathrooms.



#### **Dietary recommandations**

The food in Northern Transylvania is very similar to the Hungarian cuisine. The predominant use of pork and chicken meat, potatoes and vegetable soups characterizes the region's dishes.



#### How to get to Brașov

Brasov airport was opened in mid-June and for the moment there are limited options available for arrivals in Brașov through this airport.

The primary entry point to Romania by air is <u>Bucharest Henri Coanda Airport</u>, located 160 km away from Brasov. This airport offers numerous air travel options, ensuring convenient and timely arrivals for those heading to Brasov.

Train departs <u>Bucharest Henri Coanda Airport</u> to <u>North Train Station</u> every 20 minutes, tickets cost 1 euro. Trains to Brasov available hourly from North Train Station, tickets under 18 euros.

The most highly recommended transfer option from <u>Bucharest Henri Coanda Airport</u> is by using a <u>car</u> <u>transfer</u> option, which come at a cost of 27 euro.

#### How to get to Târgu Lăpuș

A second option for attending TCC 2023 is to arrive directly to Târgu Lăpuș. The closest airport is <u>Cluj</u> <u>Airport</u>. From Cluj to Târgu Lăpuș there are one <u>direct bus</u> option (leaving Cluj at 15.25 and arriving in Târgu Lăpuș at 17.25). For the Hungarian participants another option is to arrive by train or bus in Baia Mare and from there many bus options to Târgu Lăpuș are available.
