



REGULATIONS

on the organization and conduct of student organization activities

Preamble

These Regulations govern how students may establish their own associations, with a view to conducting cultural, sports, training, mutual aid, environmental protection or other activities, and are compliant with the Law of Higher Education no. 199 of 2023, as subsequently amended, and with the Charter of Transilvania University of Braşov.

Art. 1 Transilvania University of Braşov recognises the students' right of association in order to conduct cultural, sports, tourist, training, mutual aid, environmental protection, entertainment and other activities. Transilvania University of Braşov sustains the activities undertaken within student organizations, by providing material and logistical support for their smooth conduct.

Art. 2 Student associations are nonprofits. Within Transilvania University of Braşov, no student association may conduct profit-making activities. No student association may operate in order for a person to gain material benefits. The activities of the student associations imply providing services to students, for purposes of leisure, entertainment, education, professional training, personal growth or development of an entrepreneurial mindset, which activities complement the professional training achieved through the academic study programmes.

Art. 3 The activities conducted within student organizations have volunteerism as their fundamental principle, with the students being free to choose the association where to apply themselves, as well as the activities which they are willing to undertake. No student may be forced into activities organised by various student associations, unless s/he is willing to. All students participating in the relevant activities assume the objectives and purposes of those associations, acting knowingly to achieve them.

Art. 4 The articles of association of a student organization include its objectives, members, management bodies, assets and available funds. Within Transilvania University of Braşov, every student association shall submit a copy of its articles of association, as well as of the documentary evidence for the acquisition of its legal personality, to the Vice-Rectorate for Students and the Liaison with the Socio-Economic Environment.

Art. 5 Transilvania University of Braşov does not recognise unregistered student associations. Acceptance on the university campus and provision of support require the association's legal registration, statement of purpose, as well as lawful registration in the academic records.

Art. 6 An association's assets may only be used for the purpose it was established. A student association's assets include movable and immovable property accounting for the association members' contribution in kind, registered as its assets and made available to its members. No student association's assets include movable or immovable property of Transilvania University of Braşov. The University provides student associations with adequate premises where to conduct their activities, as well as with other movable and

immovable property, which remain in the University's ownership. No association may claim that, by using certain assets for a period of time, it acquires rights of disposal or use over them.

Art. 7 The association funds come from membership fees, donations, sponsorships, accessed project grants, financial resources supplied by the EU or other organizations, etc. The funds used by the student associations must be legal. No student association may spend funds obtained through illegal activities. Any student association that infringes the country's laws on the source of funds shall be immediately reported. Transilvania University of Braşov does not take responsibility for the legality of the funds used by the student associations operating therein.

Art. 8 The headquarters of any student association must be specified in its articles of association. Transilvania University of Braşov provides support to student associations by offering them, free of charge, adequate facilities for the conduct of the activities referred to in their articles of association. These facilities may serve as headquarters of the student associations, if the latter deem this appropriate. Student associations may only use the provided facilities for the activities referred to in their articles of association. The facilities made available to the student associations may not be used for commercial purposes. These facilities must be used in such a way as to prevent damage thereto. Damage resulting from inappropriate use of the facilities shall be borne by the associations concerned.

Art. 9 Certain activities of the student associations require approval from the University Management in order to take place within Transilvania University of Braşov. The University offers full support to the student associations, but considers that their activities must be public, for all students' benefit. The activities of the student organizations may not take place secretly, in promiscuity or in semi-darkness. The student associations under Transilvania University of Braşov must make their offer public, promote their objectives, and conduct their activities in plain sight, among students, for their benefit.

Art. 10 The activities of the student associations under Transilvania University of Braşov must be at a high cultural level. Student associations shall promote civility, genuine culture, initiative, the spirit of mutual assistance, entrepreneurial support, love of nature, love of country, respect for ancestors, etc. No student association may operate within Transilvania University of Braşov unless its objectives comply with these requirements.

Art. 11 There is no limit to the number of student associations within the University. The initiative of establishing new student associations comes from the students. The University neither dissolves nor establishes, on its own or on behalf of third parties, student associations. The management of the established student associations is taken over, when a generation of students ends its term of service, by the new one. Operation continuity for student associations rests with the members thereof.
