

THE PROGRAMME "DOCTORAL GRANTS FOR UNITBV INTERNATIONAL GRADUATES"

The programme **"Doctoral Grants for UNITBV International Graduates"** will continue running in the academic year 2023 - 2024. Through this programme, scholarships for doctoral studies will be granted from the university's own revenues to the most performing international students from non-EU or non-EEA countries.

1. ELIGIBILITY

The candidates must fulfil the following conditions:

- graduate a Master's programme or a Medical programme (6 years) within Transilvania University of Brașov;
- submit a complete application file, according to point 4 (see below).

2. DURATION

The scholarship for doctoral studies is granted yearly, for the complete period of a doctoral study cycle, for which the candidate is accepted for studies at Transilvania University of Brașov.

The maintenance of the scholarship status is conditioned by the fulfilment of the contractual obligations, in accordance with the individual doctoral programme.

3. SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

The scholarship will cover: the tuition fees (including the registration and graduation fees); free accommodation in the university's dormitories during the entire university year (12 months); a monthly allowance for subsistence expenses (12 months, yearly), with a quantum established by the Executive Board for each academic year, as well as the reimbursement of the expenses with the residence permit for studies – consular fees (currently amounting the equivalent in lei of 120 euro) and the value of the permit (currently of 259 lei). For the academic year 2023 – 2024, the quantum of the monthly allowance is 1,500 lei.

4. THE APPLICATION FILE

The application file will include the following documents:

4.1- application form (available on the university website);

- 4.2- updated Curriculum Vitae;
- 4.3- description of the research project (maximum 2 pages; the bibliography is counted separately);
- 4.4- preliminary agreement from a doctoral supervisor (template available at: https://view.officeapps.live.com/op/view.aspx?src=https%3A%2F%2Fwww.unitb v.ro%2Fdocumente%2Fadmission%2Fadmission_non_Eu_citizens%2FPreliminar y_agreement_of_the_PhD_supervisor-2022-

MA.doc&wdOrigin=BROWSELINK) - in original.

To obtain the preliminary agreement, candidates can either directly contact the preferred doctoral supervisor, or submit a letter of intent to the Interdisciplinary Doctoral School (e-mail: <u>director-sdi@unitbv.ro</u>) – to support them in identifying the most appropriate doctoral supervisor. The letter of intent should be accompanied by the supporting documents 4.1. + 4.2. + 4.3.

All documents will be elaborated in English language.

The application file will be submitted in original, at the International Cooperation Office, Rectorate building, B-dul Eroilor no. 29.

5. CANDIDATES' SELECTION

The candidates' selection is done by an Evaluation Committee, appointed by the Rector of Transilvania University of Brasov, consisting of:

- the Vice-Rector responsible with the scientific research;
- the Vice-Rector responsible with the internationalization and the quality evaluation;
- the Director of the Council for Doctoral Studies.

The final decision will be taken by the Executive Board based on the proposal of the Evaluation Committee.

All candidates will be contacted by e-mail after the selection process is completed.

The deadline for submitting the application file for the doctoral grants is **<u>31.05.2023</u>**.
